#### How TBA Ballet Awards Work and Rules

- → Competition classes based on competitors' age as at 24th August 2024
- → Two sections of entry; Solo Classes and the TBA Award Classes

#### TBA AWARD CLASSES:

- → Each competitor will compete in two dances, two classes; Classical and Own Choice/ Variation, in their age category.
- → For classes that have more than 10 competitors entered a first, second and third, fourth and fifth place will be awarded at each age level. For classes that have less than 10 competitors entered a first, second and third place will be awarded at each age level.
- → The placed competitors will then compete against each other again at the Finals Awards.
- → One winner will be awarded The Ballet Academy Award for their performance at their age group level. This winner will receive a trophy.



### **Entry Registration and Fees**

Entries Open: Tuesday 28th May 2024

Entries Close: Thursday August 1st 2024, unless capacity is reached sooner

#### **ENTRIES ARE STRICTLY LIMITED**

If able to accommodate late entries, these will incur an additional \$20 late fee

#### **Payment Method:**

Payment made with Debit/Credit Card at time of entry and confirms your entry.

### Rules of Entry

- 1. Online Entries ONLY are accepted forms of competition entry
- 2. **Payment** must accompany online registration form as completion of your entry
- 3. **Age** of dancer is taken from the first day of competition 24th August, 2024.
- 4. The Ballet Academy Awards are open to amateur dancers only. Up to and including 18 year olds.
- 5. Competitors perform at their own risk. The Ballet Academy is not liable for any accident or injury of any description. First Aid certified members and volunteers are present should there be any injury requiring intervention. Serious injury or accident will result in you or The Ballet Academy calling emergency services.
- 6. **Music** needs to be uploaded via The Ballet Academy Awards APP when requested by the competition.
- 7. **Photographs** may be taken of your dancer and shared on The Ballet Academy social media platforms.
- 8. Images or videos where The Ballet Academy has been tagged may be re-shared by The Ballet Academy on our social media platforms.



- 9. You may not photograph or video another dancer (other than your own) unless you have explicit permission from their parent or guardian.
- 10. **The Order of Performance** will stay the order stated in the programme, unless otherwise directed by the Stage Manager. If a registered competitor is absent when called to stage, they, at the discretion of The Ballet Academy forfeit their competition time.
- 11. **Placed Competitors** awarded first, second or third place during preliminaries **must** be available and present to compete at the Final Awards.
- 12. **Time Limits** will be strictly adhered to and are 3 mins per dance.
- 13. **Copyright.** All non-variation dances must demonstrate original/ un-plagerised choreography. The competitor and their tutor/ choreographer are responsible for clearing all performance rights to any choreographed works that are not in the public domain. The Ballet Academy accepts no responsibility for potential plagiarism of choreography, nor identifying it.
- 14. The Adjudicator's decision is final in all classes and is not open for discussion or dispute.
- 15. COMPETITORS WHO HAVE HAD COACHING, TUITION or LESSONS more than once with the adjudicator within the last 12 months are not eligible to enter the competition.
- 16. There is to be no communication with the adjudicator at the competitions by competitors, their supporters (including and not limited to; parents, whanau, family, teachers, advisors).



- 17. The Ballet Academy reserves the right to replace the advertised adjudicator at the discretion of The Ballet Academy. Should this result in entrants no longer being able to participate in the The Ballet Academy awards, a refund will be given.<sup>1</sup>
- 18. Only registered competitors and ONE accompanying parent/ caregiver/ support/ manager (plus their minors) are allowed access to **backstage areas**.
- 19. All **Cups and Trophies** remain the property of The Ballet Academy and must be returned to the Trophy Steward, upon request, in advance of the following years Award.
- 20. **Photography and Videography** is STRICTLY of your own registered competitor. Flash photography and videography is prohibited at all times.
- 21. NO photography or videography is permitted at the finals evening of The Ballet Academy Awards.
- 22. The Ballet Academy reserves the right to remove any person who is deemed to be behaving inappropriately; dangerous, bullying, thieving, abusive and/ or not respecting the requests of The Ballet Academy representatives and volunteers.
- 23. Should The Ballet Academy fail to reach **sufficient entries** to ensure Awards are viable, we reserve the right to cancel the competition in which all fees paid will be refunded.
- 24. **No smoking** is permitted on the premises or on the grounds of the theatre and surrounding school.

25. The Ballet Academy reserves the right to interpret these rules as they see fit. The Ballet Academy decisions are final and not open for discussion.

### Solo Classes Rules:

- Each competitor is assigned and represented by a number (name is withheld from adjudicator)
- Each dance must be 3 minutes or less.
- Own Choice Dance may be e.g. Neo-Classical, Lyrical, Contemporary or Student Choreography. It may not be choreography from an examination syllabus.
- Solo Classes will be awarded the traditional: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, VHC, HC, C placings. Not limited to assigning each place nor only one competitor per placing.

### Specific Solo Award Rules:

- Each competitor assigned and represented by a number (name is withheld from adjudicator)
- Each dance must be 3 minutes or less.
- Own Choice Dance may be e.g. Barefoot, Neo-Classical, Demi-Character, Lyrical or Contemporary. It may not be choreography from an examination syllabus.
- Both dances are to be costumed in appropriate attire for the dance styles.
- Own dance may use props.



- All competitors will dance in the assigned order for their classical dance section, then
  their own dance section will immediately follow in the same assigned order. Bear this in
  mind when determining drastic changes between dances e.g. hair styles.
- At completion of dancing both Classical and Own Dance; first, second and third places will be awarded. The three placed dancers will then be required to compete again in the Finals evening.
- You must be prepared and side stage before your number is called for your Own Dance.
   There will be no waiting for a competitor or swapping order of competing between sections.

### Specific Solo w. Variation Award Rules:

- Each competitor assigned and represented by a number (name is withheld from adjudicator)
- Each dance must be 3 minutes or less.



- Variation MUST be from a Classical Ballet.
- Female dancers must perform Variation en Pointe if 13 years or older. 12 years, variation on pointe is optional.
- Both dances are to be costumed in appropriate attire for the dance styles.
- All competitors will dance in the assigned order for their Classical dance section, then
  their Variation section will immediately follow in the same assigned order. Bear this in
  mind when determining drastic changes between dances e.g. hair styles.
- At completion of dancing both Classical and Variation; first, second and third places will be awarded. The three placed dancers will then be required to compete again in the Final Awards.
- You must be prepared and side stage before your number is called for your Variation.
   There will be no waiting for a competitor or swapping order of competing between sections.

### **TBA Awards Finals** Performance Rules:

(additional to overall competition rules and guidelines)

- Competitors will dance in the order assigned by The Ballet Academy and announced in advance of the Finals Award Performance. All Classical dances will be performed by each age group, then all Own Choice/ Variations will be performed.
- TBA Solo Awards Finalists will perform their Classical Dance
- TBA Variation Awards Finalists will perform their Variation Dance
- All dancers will be called onto stage at the conclusion of performances for the Awards Ceremony.
